The results provided in this disclosure may differ from the data collected by the [Pennsylvania State Board of Nursing](https://www.pennsylvania.gov/education/boards-of-nursing/) who publishes results from NCLEX-PN first-time test takers for a reporting period that begins on October 1 and ends on September 30 of each year.
