The NCLEX-PN is a standardized examination administered by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing that Practical Nursing program graduates must pass in order to be licensed to practice as a practical nurse. The results provided in this disclosure may differ from the data collected by the [New Jersey Board of Nursing](https://www.nj.gov/health/boards/nursing/) who publishes results from NCLEX-PN first-time test takers for a reporting period that begins on January 1 and ends on December 31 of each year.
