✦ The following data reflects the results for graduates of the Practical Nursing program who took the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN) during the cohort periods as required by the Accrediting Commission of Careers Schools and Colleges. The NCLEX-PN is a standardized examination administered by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing that Practical Nursing program graduates must pass in order to be licensed to practice as a practical nurse. The results provided in this disclosure may differ from the data collected by the [Connecticut Board of Examiners for Nursing](https://www.nclex.com/) who publish results from NCLEX-PN first-time test takers for a reporting period that begins on May 1 and ends on April 30 of each year.
