

2022 Mark Hallquist Scholarship Program Application

Background:

Lincoln Technical Institute in East Windsor, CT is honored to offer the Mark Hallquist Scholarship to qualified applicants. This scholarship has been established in memory of Mr. Hallquist and has been made possible thanks to donations from his family and friends. Mark graduated from the Automotive Technology program at Lincoln Technical Institute in New Britain, CT when the school was known as New England Technical Institute. He began his training after working several low-skilled jobs, but thanks in great part to the training he received at Lincoln, he was able to have a satisfying career in the auto field.

The Mark Hallquist Scholarship is designed to provide financial assistance to a qualified applicant who meets the criteria established below and enrolls in the Automotive Technology program at Lincoln Technical Institute in East Windsor, CT each fall.

Eligibility Requirements:

In order to apply for the Mark Hallquist Scholarship, an eligible student must:

- Be 21 years of age or older;
- Have prior work experience in the field;
- Complete the application process to enroll;
- Start the Automotive Technology or Diesel Technology program by August 1, 2022;
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA);
- Submit your Mark Hallquist Scholarship application to the Front Desk in the Main Lobby; and
- Submit an essay explaining why you deserve the scholarship and what your career goals are within the automotive field.

The student who is awarded the scholarship must maintain satisfactory academic progress. Only students that meet the qualifications listed above, and the admissions requirements in order to be considered an enrolled student, can apply for this scholarship.

Scholarship Award:

Eligible students may apply for this scholarship with an award of \$1,500. The scholarship will be prorated over the entire length of his/her program and is specifically intended to cover expenses related to tuition costs. The Mark Hallquist Scholarship Committee made up of faculty and/or industry advisory members, as well as Mr. Hallquist's brother, will make the final decision regarding the award.

The deadline for submitting applications is August 1, 2022. Winners of the scholarship will be notified in writing by school administration. The notification will include the amount being awarded and start date for the program. This award is a scholarship and does not require any form of repayment to Lincoln Technical Institute.
